CHNW is still offering many great deals on apartments. If you refer a friend, you could get a rent credit! It's easy. Contact Shawn for more information at (503)-222-7105

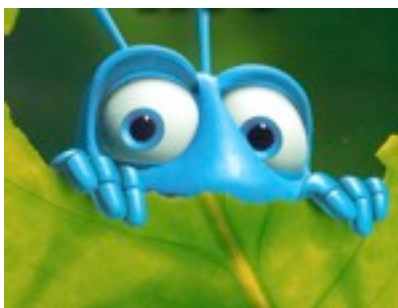

#### Tips on how to avoid bed bugs Bed Bugs Increase

Bed bugs are on the rise. Although they are not likely to make you sick, some people have an allergic reaction to them. If you think you may have bed bugs, please contact the leasing office

immediately to report it and we will schedule an exterminator. Things to look for may include small dark spots on your bedding or mattress. Bed bugs like dark places and are most active an hour before dawn.

You may find them in mattress seams, inside the mattress, underneath furniture in the back of furniture, on the underside of drawers and on the back of pictures. Avoid getting used furniture or taking free items left by another. Items abandoned by someone may have bed bugs and should be avoided. Bed bugs normally leave red, itchy, rash-like bites. You may have a few or a few hundred at a time. They are hard to distinguish from other bug bites, so checking your apartment home for bed bugs will help you to confirm what kind of bite it is.

Again, if you believe you may have bed bugs, call our leasing office to report it immediately.
